The Maine Juvenile Justice Advisory Group (JJAG) has issued a Request for Application (RFA) from small, racially diverse, community-based organizations that work in their local communities with youth (up to age 25) and their families. The purpose of this grant funding is to support these organizations working locally with youth and families to build community strength in ways that help keep youth in these communities out of the justice system. Specifically, the goal is to assist and empower organizations to respond to a youth's misconduct in ways that promote community safety and build the youth's capacity for vital connections within their families and communities.
